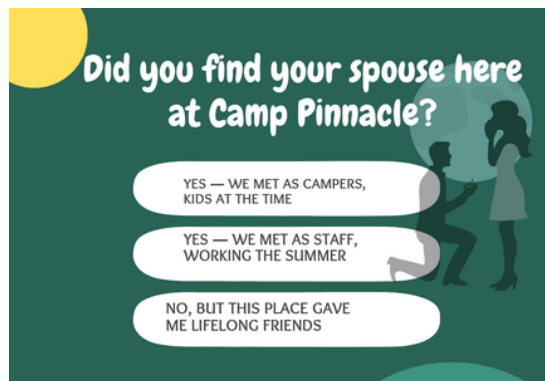


Dear Pinnacle Family,
